## Property Owners Responsibility

No property owner shall cause, or permit any installation, connection, addition, or alteration to be made to any water, drain, soil, waste pipe, or any pipe connected thereto, unless a permit therefore shall have first been issued by the Plumbing Department of the Sewerage and Water Board (as prescribed in 2.2.4 S&WB Plumbing Code).

A Licensed Master Plumber (registered with sewerage and water board) is required to file a plumbing permit to install, construct, reconstruct, alter, or repair any plumbing system, or do any work in connection with the plumbing or plumbing systems to the public sewers, and water mains under the control of the Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans (as prescribed in 2.2.1). Plumbing fixtures to be reset to existing systems shall conform to the passages stated above.

Inspections shall be conducted for all new work, and such portions of existing systems as may be affected by new work, or any changes to ensure compliance with all the requirements of the Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans Plumbing Code (as prescribed in 3.2).

If any plumbing system, or part thereof which is installed, altered, or repaired, is covered before being inspected, tested, and approved as prescribed by code, it shall be uncovered for inspection. Compliance to these conditions is required to protect the health and safety of the public. **Failure to comply shall result in water service interruption.**

Whoever violates any of the rules and regulations established by the Board and duly promulgated in the official journal of the City shall be fined not more than one thousand dollars for each offense or imprisoned not more than thirty days, or both.
