We’re Improving Your Water System – Louisiana Avenue

Sewerage and Water Board will perform water line work on Louisiana Avenue. Boh Brothers Construction Company, working for Sewerage and Water Board and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, will **perform a tie-in of an 8” water line that services the area.**

Residents and businesses on Louisiana Avenue between Magnolia Street and S. Claiborne Avenue will experience low water pressure on Thursday, March 9 and Friday, March 10, 2017 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. on both days.

This work is part of the \$82.6 million SELA Louisiana Avenue Canal Project.

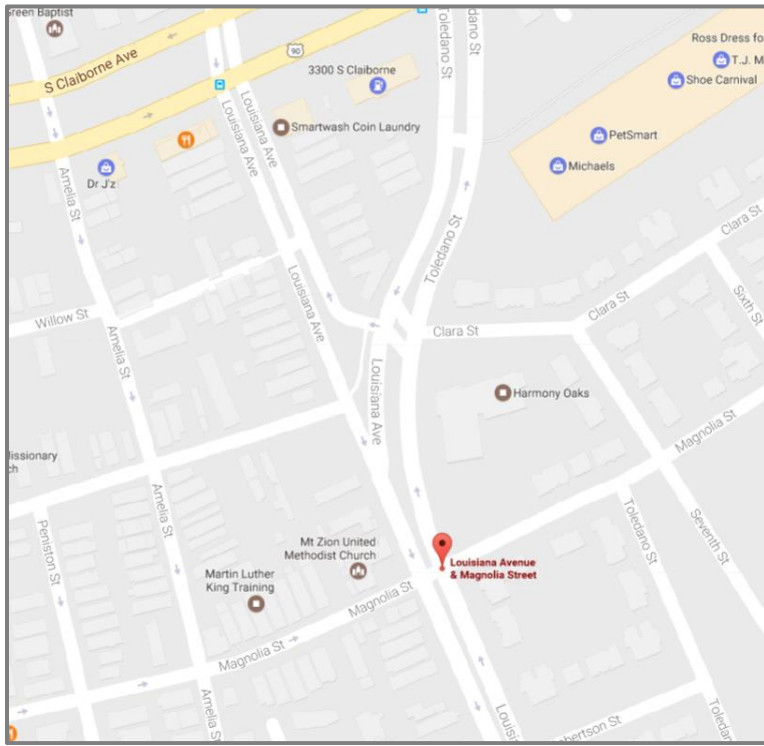
