Sewerage and Water Board will be performing water line work on Camp Street. Boh Brothers Construction Company, working for Sewerage and Water Board and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, will be **performing a tie-in of a new 20” water line that will service the area.**

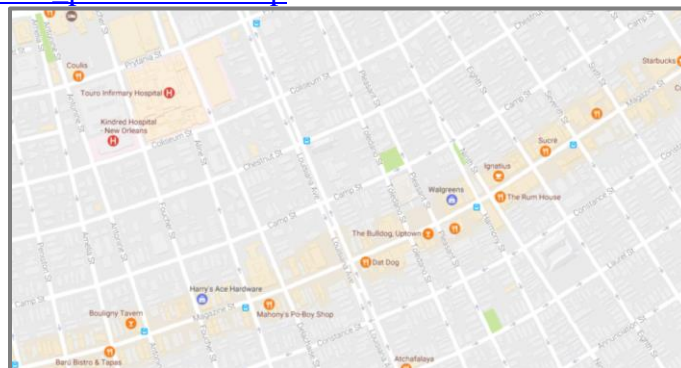
