Sewerage and Water Board will be performing water line work in the Uptown area. Sewerage and Water Board crews will be repairing broken fire hydrants that service the area.

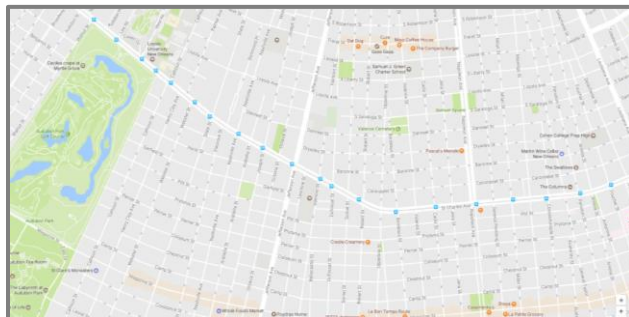
Residents and businesses in parts of the Uptown area may experience low water pressure on Friday, January 13, 2017 from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.
