## We’re improving your water system – Gentilly/Fairgrounds Area

Sewerage and Water Board crews and the Department of Public Works contractor, Hard Rock Construction, will perform a **waterline repair and water valve replacement in the Gentilly/Fairgrounds area**. One lane of traffic will be closed at the intersection of Gentilly Boulevard and Castiglione Street while work is in progress.

Residents and businesses on several streets in the Gentilly/Fairgrounds area will experience low water pressure on **Monday, February 6, 2017 from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.**

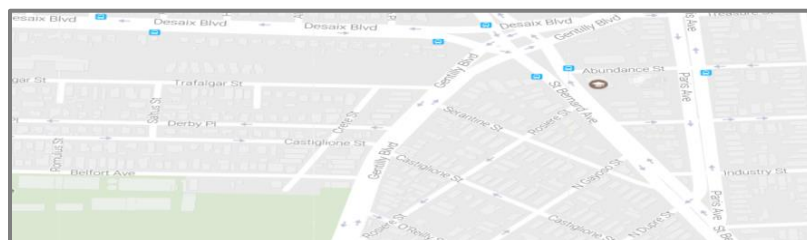
