We’re improving your sewer system – Traffic Advisory - Paris Avenue

Wallace C. Drennan Contractors, working for Sewerage and Water Board **will perform sewer system work that will affect traffic flow on Paris Avenue.**

Residents, businesses and motorists are advised that the intersection of Paris Avenue and Prentiss Avenue will have lane closures for approximately three weeks beginning **Monday, March 13th through Friday, March 31, 2017.** The southbound lanes of Paris Avenue from Prentiss Avenue to Crescent Street will have two-way traffic until work is completed. Traffic controls will be in place.

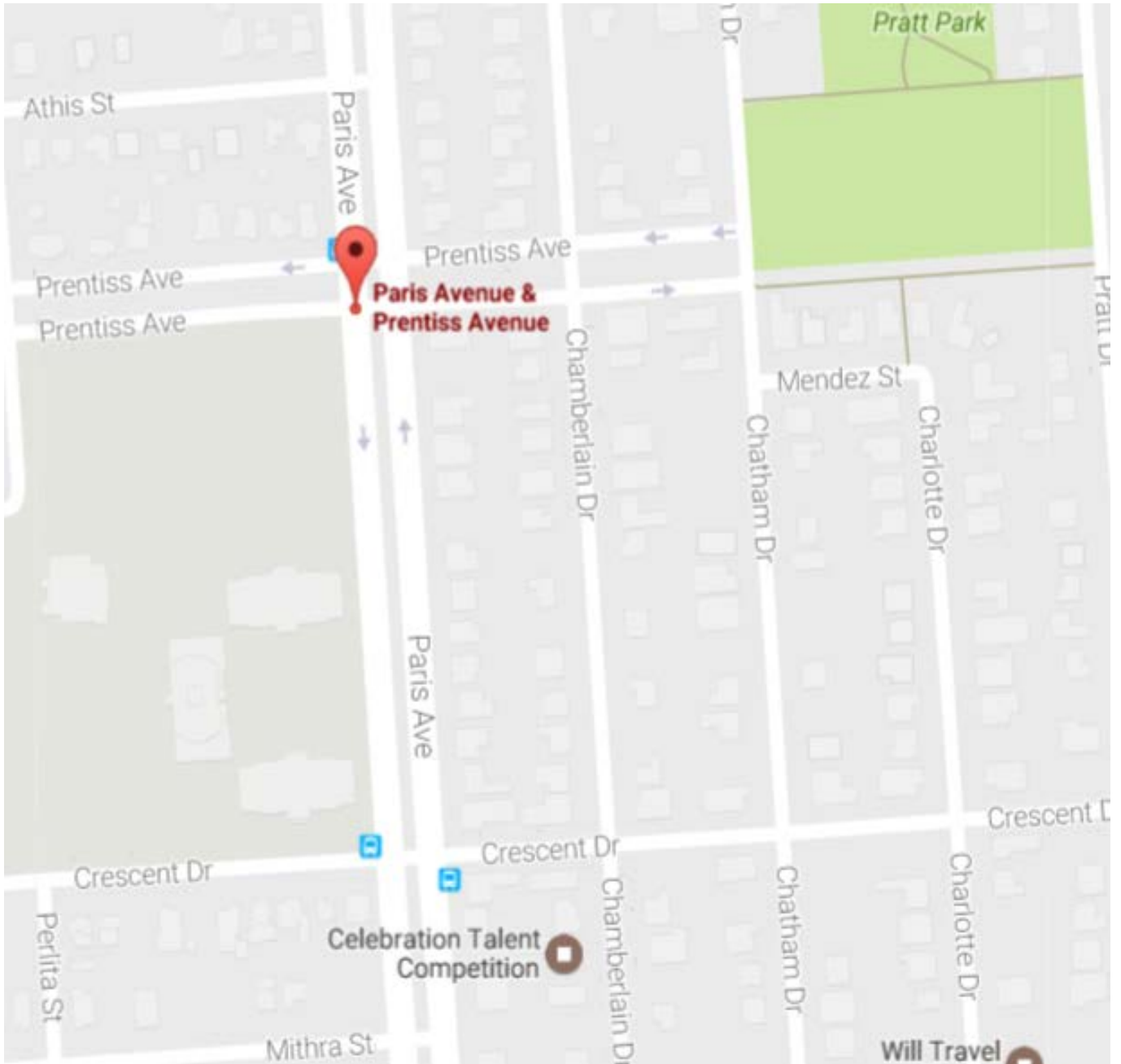
