Sewerage and Water Board crews and Wallace Drennan Construction Company will **perform water line repairs in the Seventh Ward Area** that will affect traffic flow.

Residents, businesses on Republic Street from N. Broad Street to N. Rocheblave Street will experience **low water pressure on Thursday, February 2, 2017 from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.**

Motorists are also advised that the right lane on N. Broad Street between Republic and Duels streets and Duels Street between Bruxelles and N. Broad streets will be closed to traffic.

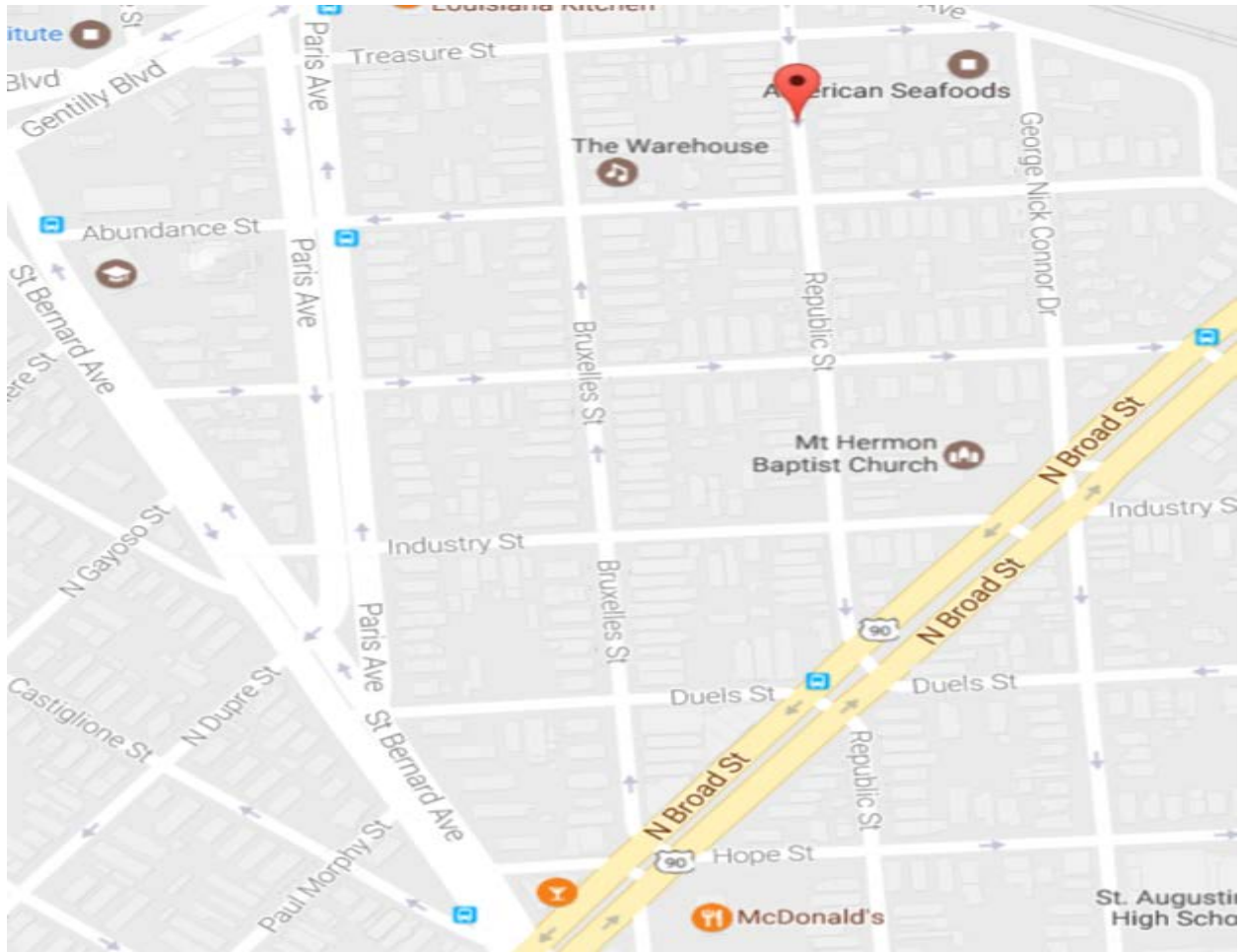
