## DELINQUENT BILL PROCESS

An unpaid bill becomes delinquent if it's greater than $\$ 50$ and older than 60 days.


Once a bill becomes delinquent, the following steps will be taken if the bill remains unpaid.


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[^0]:    A customer would be removed from the collections cycle for the following:
    $\star$ Customer has a Special Payment Arrangement in good standing.
    $\star$ Customer requests a high bill investigation.
    $\star$ Customer requests a hearing or re-hearing after receiving the results of a high bill investigation.
    $\star$ Customer has been granted a low-income exemption.
    $\star$ Customer has been granted a medical or other at-risk exemption.
